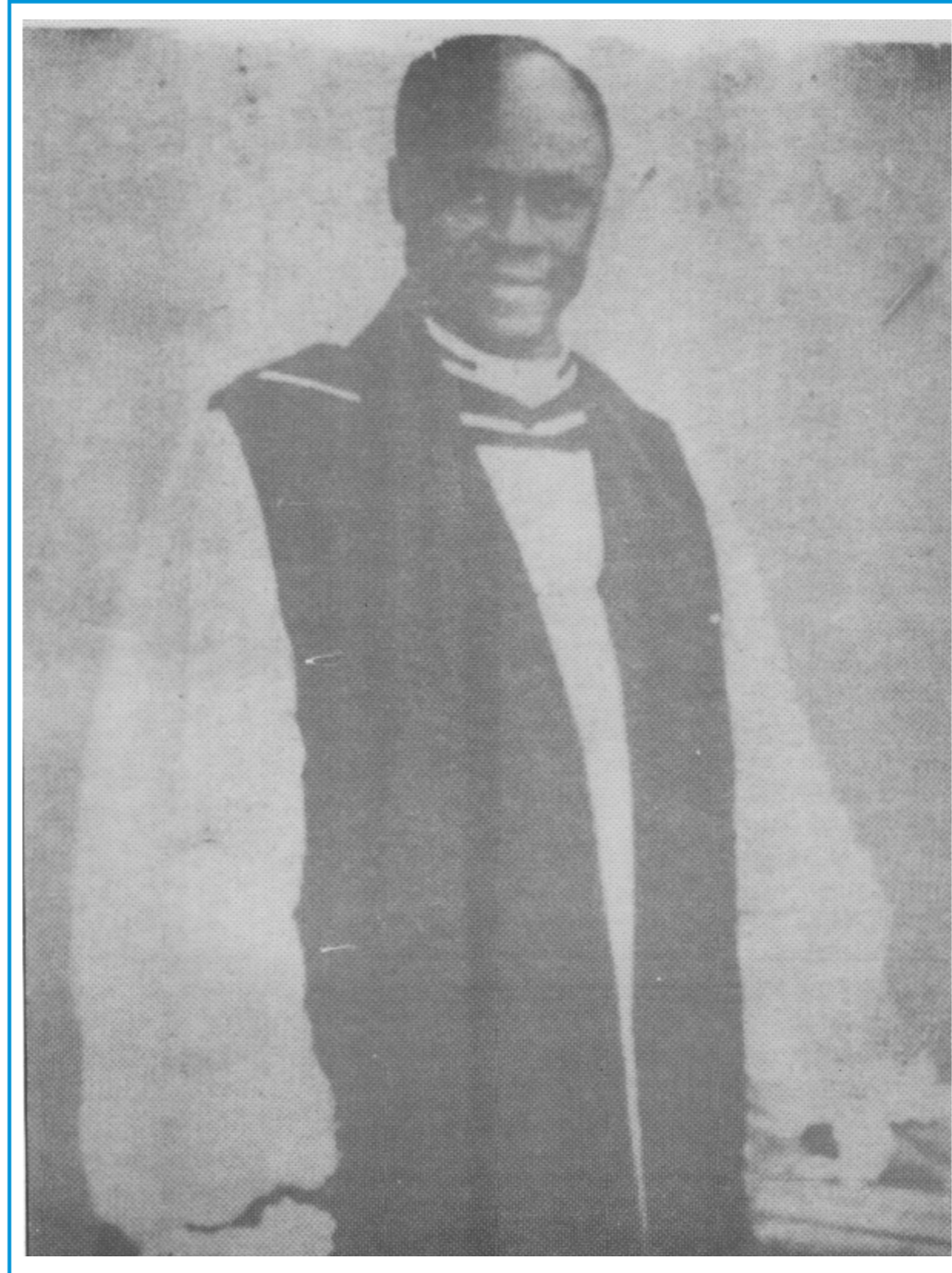

7. Perimeter Fencing of the school started with fixing of a wide stretch of fence affected by storm.
8. Renovation and decoration of Emmanuel Alayande Hall to wear a new look has commenced.
